Lunch Bunch:

Lunch Bunch is offered Monday - Friday, 12:00 - 1:00pm for Twos - Pre-K children. The fee is \$3.50 per day. The children bring their lunch and a drink.

Lunch Bunch fees are billed in arrears on the following month's tuition invoice.

Registration:

Our registration fee is \$70.00 for the first child, and \$50.00 for each sibling. *Registration fees are nonrefundable.*

Registration information will be available during the month of January. Completed forms, along with the registration fee, should be submitted to the Director to secure your space for the next school year.

Priority for Acceptance:

- 1st -Currently enrolled children
- 2nd -Siblings of enrolled children
- 3rd -Children of church members
- 4th -Children from our waiting list

Immunization records are due by the first day of school.

Thirty day written notice is requested to withdraw a child from the program.
