### Week One, June 14 - 18

## CLASSES

Children will be placed in classes based on their classroom assignments for the Fall of 2010.

### **3 Days (M-W-F) for Ages 2 & 3**

Three day campers begin their day at **9:30**, and have the option of staying for lunch (until **1:00**), or ending their day at **12:00**. **Decisions regarding lunch participation must be made at the time of registration, due to staffing needs.**

All two year olds must be two by June 1, and separate easily from their parents. Exceptions to these requirements will be determined by the director and staff.

**Twos Parents: Summer Camp themes will not be emphasized as much in the Twos. Our Twos' camp will focus more on play and adjusting to preschool.**

### **5 Days for Ages 4, 5 & 6**

All camp classes for these children are from **9:30am - 1:00pm**.  
Classes are grouped by age.

## LUNCH

Lunch time is included in our day for our 5 day campers, and is optional for our 3 day campers. Lunches are sent from home. Healthy, peanut-free, mid-morning snacks are provided by the school.

## REGISTRATION

The Registration/Activity Fee is:  
\$20 per child
